

Midweek Cycling Tours In Suffolk

4 NIGHT MIDWEEK TOURS

Available from 1st June - 14th July
Start Monday, Finish Friday.

START AT BUCKLESHAM

Highlights: Find out what Suffolk is all about. Traditional scenery and easy cycling in the Heart of Suffolk.

Covering the same route as above but with your extra day spent cycling the in the Heart of Suffolk rather than the Witch Finder Way. The Heart of Suffolk offers some of the quietest lanes in the county and is set amongst pretty villages, flint churches and gently rolling countryside. Places to visit include a working windmill at Saxted and the attractive village of Debenham.

Day 1, Monday

Arrive in Bucklesham

Drive to your starting campsite near Bucklesham, E of Ipswich. You will park your vehicle here for the duration of your holiday.
Bicycles will be delivered to your tent during the day.

Day 4, Tuesday

Bucklesham to Wickham Market

Wind your way through (or around) the Victorian Seaside town of Felixstowe and then onto the River Deben foot ferry. From here you travel near the coast to historic Orford, where you can take a boat trip or visit the castle. Turning inland through forest lined lanes will take you towards Wickham Market.

You can bypass Felixstowe to avoid traffic and take a variety of forest tracks from Orford instead of sticking to the cycle route.

Day 5, Wednesday

Day tour in the Heart of Suffolk (Optional Rest Day)

Exploring the heart of Suffolk will enable you to experience what much of Suffolk is all about. From small villages characterised by thatched and colour washed cottages, to historic buildings and rolling fields, this day tour takes in some of Suffolk's most rural landscape. Cycling via Framlingham you follow the Deben valley towards the most attractive small town of Debenham, then swinging right along pretty lanes leading through small villages with their characteristic flint built churches. You can then cycle towards a working windmill at Saxted before returning to the campsite.

Alternatively enjoy a rest day or a look around either Wickham Market, which is just up the road, or Framlingham a few miles to the north. If you fancy some forest cycling then Rendlesham forest is not too far away either.

Day 4, Thursday

Wickham Market to Bucklesham

Cycle through the attractive estate village of Easton and on to the ancient market town of Framlingham. Visit the castle or muse the many attractive buildings that border the streets and alleyways that lead off from the triangular market square. Continuing through attractive rolling countryside and historic hamlets you will eventually arrive in the former shipbuilding town of Woodbridge, set on the River Deben.

From here you pass the riverside and sailing community of Waldringfield before arriving at your campsite near Bucklesham.

Take a more direct route cutting out Framlingham or alternatively extend your journey by taking in some of the Heart of Suffolk route.
