MINI CYCLING TOUR - SUFFOLK COASTAL ROUTE - START IN EYKE

Enjoy a self guided mini tour of the suffolk coastal route, choosing a distance suitable to you! The Suffolk Coastal Route has much to offer along its 88 mile length, from quiet country lanes that pass through the forests and heaths that typify this rural part of the county to historic market towns such as Framlingham and Woodbridge.

Day 1, Friday

Arrive in Eyke

Drive to your starting campsite near Eyke, NE of Woodbridge. You will park your vehicle here for the duration of your holiday. Bicycles will be delivered to your tent during the day.

Day 2, Saturday

Eyke to Bucklesham

Cycle through Wickham Market and along the coastal route before visiting the historic shipbuilding town of Woodbridge. From here you will wind your way through the sailing village of Waldringfield and onto your campsite in Bucklesham.

You have a longer option to cycle into Framlingham and visit the historic castle or quirky shops lining the small streets and alley ways, or a shorter route missing out Wickham Market.

Day 3, Sunday

Bucklesham to Eyke

This part of the tour takes you around the Victorian seaside town of Felixstowe, now the busiest container port in the UK. From here you will cross the River Deben estuary (by foot & cycle ferry for which a small fare is required) to the pretty Bawdsey Quay. Carrying on along the coastal route and then through Rendlesham Forest - a vast area of forest, famous for UFO sightings. Together with Tunstall and Dunwich Forests, the three forests cover much of the sandy heath lands found along the Suffolk coastline. The forest routes open up some excellent off road cycling opportunities before arriving at your next site in Eyke.

Bypass Felixstowe if you like and choose from any number of forest tracks or an on road option if you prefer.
